

Home-made **Liquid Calcium** Recipe


Calcium extract from eggshells

In glass or plastic container, add

5 cups vinegar (clear or apple cider vinegar but must be 5%)


1 cup crushed not powdered **eggshells**

Label this. Steep 5 days. Strain.

 **Apply to needy vegetables, especially squash family, as both drench and foliar application.**

 **Or use in the Boron-Calcium Liquid Fertilizer recipe**

Storage: in glass jar & plastic lid. This will not keep well for months.

 **Dilute this before applying:**
1 part extract to 7 parts non-chlorinated water, or
5 cups extract to 2 gallons of non-chlorinated water.

Rate & Time of Application:

once per season as drench & foliar application as fruits develop.

“Spent” eggshells can be grit for chickens, or mixed into compost pile, or into garden soil.
